

Recover Your Digital Banking Password

Apple (macOS/iOS)

macOS

- Open System Settings (click the Apple logo in the top-left corner and select System Settings)
- Scroll down and click on Passwords.
- Authenticate using your Mac's password or Face ID/Touch ID.
- You'll see a list of saved passwords. Find the website or app you need, and click on it to reveal the password.

iOS (iPhone/iPad)

- Open the Settings app.
- Scroll down and tap Passwords.
- Use Face ID, Touch ID, or your passcode to authenticate.
- Scroll through the list or search for the website or app to view the saved password.

Google Chrome

Desktop (Windows/macOS/Linux):

- Open Google Chrome.
- In the top-right corner, click the three dots menu and select Settings.
- Under Autofill, click on Passwords.
- You'll see a list of saved passwords. Click on the eye icon next to a password (you may need to enter your computer's password to view it).

Mobile (Android/iOS):

- Open the Chrome app.
- Tap the three dots in the top-right corner and select Settings.
- Under Basics, tap Passwords.
- You'll see a list of saved passwords for various websites. Tap on a site to view the saved password (you may need to authenticate).

Microsoft Edge

- Open Microsoft Edge.
- Click the three dots menu in the upper-right corner and choose Settings.
- Under Profiles, click on Passwords.
- You'll see a list of saved passwords. To view the password, click the eye icon next to the entry (you may be prompted for your computer's password).

Mozilla Firefox

- Open Firefox.
- Click the three lines menu in the top-right corner and select Settings.
- Select Privacy & Security from the left menu.
- Scroll down to the Logins and Passwords section and click Saved Logins.
- To view your saved passwords, click Show Passwords (you'll be prompted to enter your computer's password).

Safari (Windows – If applicable)

- Open Safari and click Edit > Preferences.
- Click the Passwords tab.
- You'll be prompted to enter your password or use Touch ID.
- View the saved passwords from the list.

Password Manager

- Open the password manager app or extension.
- Search for the website or app in the search bar.
- Click on the entry to view the username and password (authentication may be required).
